MESSAGE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Warmest Greetings to all parents, guardians and learners. It's with great pleasure – The Management, Educators and Governing Body - welcome you to Term 3 2024. I hope you had a relaxing and peaceful holiday. Its back to school and I hope you are geared up and looking forward to it.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

1. DRESS CODE:

All learners must follow the Uniform Code. Every year without fail we have learners that defy the dress code. Parents you are responsible for the way your child is attired and you need to make sure that there is no deviation.

Most times we have serious problems with the Boys' attire – long hair, indifferent haircuts, shaven eyebrows, earrings, goatees, narrow bottom pants and white socks.

All of the above is NOT allowed. Any defiance will result in the learners being sent home to rectify the situation.

Parents to avoid this make sure your child is properly attired.

2. ATTENDANCE AND LATECOMING:

School starts at 7.30am and terminates at 2.30pm. Learners should be in school by 7.25am. In Terms 1 and 2 the average attendance per day was 85%. It means that 15% of learners were absent each day – this converts to 15% x 1187(Roll)= 178 learners. The worst attendance was Grade 12 – averaging 78% per day.

It is evident that learners that attend school regularly perform better academically and frequent absenteeism retards progress. An investigation will be conducted on frequent absentees and a report will be forwarded to the Department of Education. CHILDREN NEED TO BE AT SCHOOL.

3. SCHOOL FEES:

It is absolutely heartwarming to know that many parents/guardians have updated their school fees and taken advantage of the discounts.

Further discounts are available till the end of JULY 2024.

Remember ARENA PARK SECONDARY is a self-sufficient school and we depend on payment of school fees and fund-raisers – I trust you will honour your responsibility if you are in employment.
